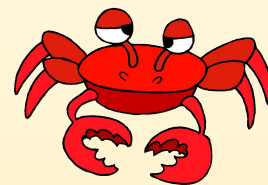

Can you believe we're already halfway through the Autumn Term! Time is flying by, and it's been wonderful to watch your little ones grow and learn as they embrace the joys of this season. A big welcome to our new families who have joined us since September. The children have all settled wonderfully this term, busy with our autumn themed activities. From baking biscuits and pizzas, learning about different fruits and vegetables, various role-play activities they've been busy exploring and developing new skills each day.

For those children in Deep Blue Sea and Lagoon who will start school in September 2025, you must apply now for your chosen Infant school, this can be done online here:

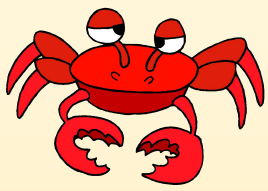

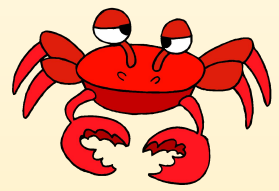

Parent Reminders

NUT FREE SITE

We are a nut-free Nursery and School due to known severe allergies with children who attend both settings. Please can you make sure that all pack lunches/tea-time snacks do not contain any nut products at all.

MOBILE PHONES

Please do not use your mobile phones on site at the Nursery during drop off and collections. Keep them in your bags/pockets until you are off the school premises. We will ask you to leave them in the Office while visiting the rooms.

GATE OPENING TIMES

The gates to the Deep Blue Sea and Coral Reef are open from 8.45am and closed at 9am prompt each morning. The gates are checked and secured ready for the children to play outside from 9am. Please do not try to open the gates if they are closed & bolted, come round to the main doors by the Office to drop off. At the end of the day the gates are open from 3.15pm to collect children and closed by 3.35pm

LATE COLLECTION FEES

If you are late to collect your children from their session, there is a £5 fee per 15 minutes you are late after the session finishes. If you collect later than 5.30pm this is £10 per 15 minutes.



Spring Term FUNDING

Please ensure that if you qualify for 15 or 30 hour working entitlement funding, that you apply and/or re-confirm ready for the Spring Term (1st January - 31st March 2025) New applications can be made now via www.childcarechoices.gov.uk

Codes must be eligible on and after 31st December 2024 to qualify for funding in the Spring Term.



To keep your 30 hours place **you** need to check your details are up to date every 3 months. Go to gov.uk/childcareaccount

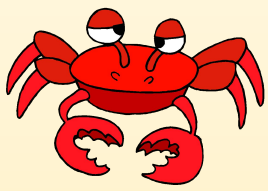

Session Fees

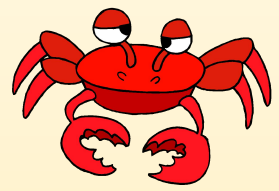

These are EMAILED so make sure that you check in the first week of each month it's come through, and MUST be paid before 28th to avoid late charges. 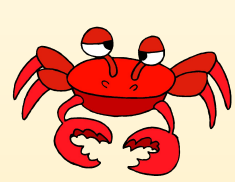
The Reef at Sheringham are offering free swim lessons to children - Please email stephaniecloxton@everyoneactive.com for your free session

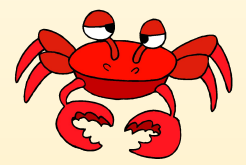
